Banking Hours and Admission Information

How do I bank my PTC courses with TCNJ?

1. Submit the registration form and fee to your PTC Coordinator (in-person only).
2. Submit the additional assignment to your PTC instructor (as instructed).

When will my PTC credits be banked with TCNJ?

In August, TCNJ Off-Site Graduate Programs will contact all PTC students who have banked credits via email. The email will provide information on how to obtain official transcripts and how to matriculate into a TCNJ graduate program.

Will I need to apply to a TCNJ graduate program to bank my PTC course?

It is not necessary to submit TCNJ's application and fee to bank credit.

PTC students may transfer in one of the following with TCNJ:

1. Four PTC courses
2. Two PTC courses and two faculty approved external transfers
3. Two faculty approved external transfers

Banked PTC courses are good for 6 years prior to admittance into a M.Ed. or post master's certificate program.

Admissions Information

1. Overseas Visiting Students - Students under this status may take up to three graduate courses (PTC 4 courses) before matriculating into a TCNJ graduate program.
2. Matriculated Students - Students planning on completing a TCNJ M.Ed. or Certificate graduate program must apply for matriculation by submitting all the following admissions' materials:

- Completed Graduate Application/Application Fee (\$75)
- Official Transcripts
- Two Recommendation Letters
- Student Essay
- Standardized Test Scores
- Resumé
