




Admission Requirements:

Certificate of Qualification Requirements

- 1. Degree Requirement
- 2. Subject Matter (60 liberal arts credits)
- 3. <u>Basic Skills Requirement</u>
 Praxis
- 4. Physiology and Hygiene Requirement
- 5. Fee Requirement



Certificate of Qualification (CQ): The CQ was developed collaboratively by the College of New Jersey (TCNJ) and the State of New Jersey Department of Education, Office of Certification and Induction. The CQ verifies completion of a teacher preparation program which allows candidates to teach abroad within the International School Community.

Certificate of Eligibility (CE): The CE is a credential with lifetime validity issued to a US Citizen who has NOT completed a teacher preparation program, but who has met the basic requirements for certification including academic study and applicable test requirements. Candidates may apply directly to the NJ Department of Education.

If possible, please have official transcripts sent to you first and then forward them in the sealed envelope(s) together with any other documents. Certification for Eligibility Requirements (CE)

Students **MUST** apply themselves. Requirements may be subject to change, we strongly encourage students to verify with NJDOE at the point of CE application.

CE Candidates ONLY <u>Teacher Certification Reciprocity (state to state)</u>

Teaching license reciprocity outlines which qualifications each state will accept from another state, and which qualifications it will not. The specific requirements for teaching certification or licensure vary in each individual state in the US. US citizens returning to the states to teach MUST verify the teacher certification reciprocity.
