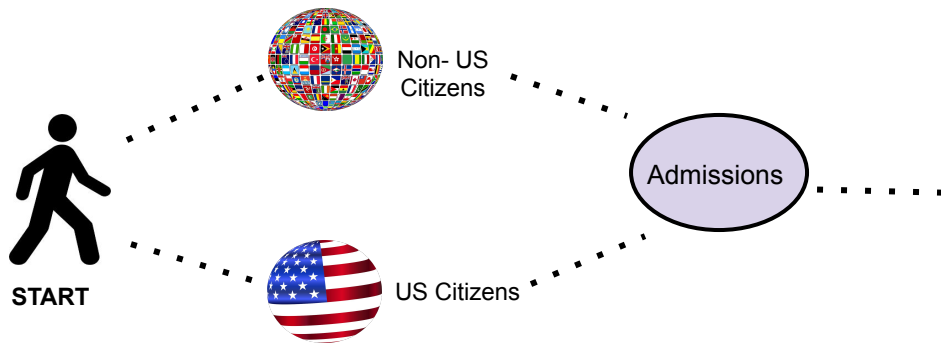

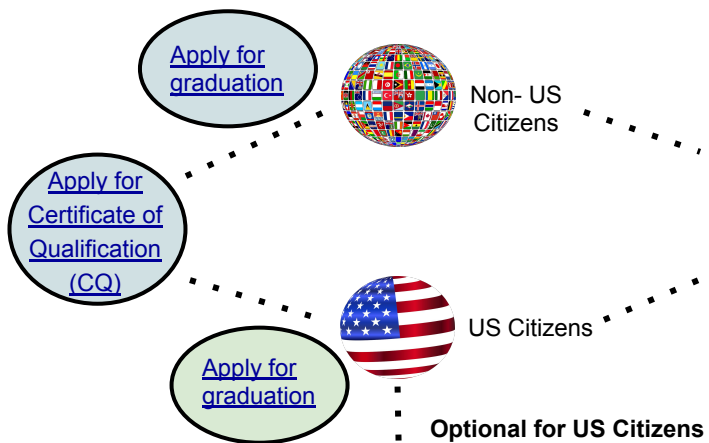

Certificate of Qualification (CQ): The Certificate of Qualification (CQ) is a graduation document and is available to all students (US Citizens and Non-US Citizens). The CQ was developed by the School of Education and it is produced and disbursed by TCNJ's Certification Office. It verifies successful completion of the required graduate coursework for a teacher preparation program. It is a credential widely recognized by International Schools and their accrediting agencies.

Certificate of Eligibility (CE): The CE is a credential with lifetime validity issued to a US Citizen who has NOT completed a teacher preparation program, but who has met the basic requirements for certification including academic study and applicable test requirements. Candidates may apply directly to the NJ Department of Education.

TO AVOID DELAYS: After applying online, please submit ALL necessary documentation together in a single packet to the address below. If possible, please have official transcripts sent to you first and then forward them in the sealed envelope(s) together with any other documents. Please include your tracking number in all correspondence with our office.
