Students may combine graduate credit from approved CTC courses (up to 6 credits) with TCNJ's International School Counseling program offered online during the academic year and at our site outside of Lisbon, Portugal during the summer.

*COUN 690 - Students MUST complete a minimum of 24 graduate credits before taking COUN 690.

**The requirements for COUN 693 may be met by taking COUN 694 Internship (3 Credits; 300 clinical hours) and COUN 695 Internship (3 Credits; 300 clinical hours) ELIGIBILITY FOR GRADUATION REQUIRES: 1) Satisfactory completion of the courses printed in the program planner; 2) A minimum of 39 graduate semester hours earned with TCNJ (abroad or online) 3) A minimum total of 48 graduate semester hours 4) A cumulative Grade Point Average of 3.0 5) Completion of all departmental requirements/prerequisites 6) A grade of B or better in COUN 501, 670, 675, 690, and 693 (or 694/695). With Departmental approval students who receive a grade of B-, C+, C, or C- in these courses or their prerequisites will be permitted to retake the course(s) in question only once to improve their grade and remain in the program. Failure to obtain a B or better in the second attempt will result in automatic termination. No student who has received a grade of B- or lower in a prerequisite course(s) will be permitted to enroll in COUN 670, 675, 690 or 693 (or 694/695) 7) A student receiving an "F" grade in any course will automatically be denied continuance in the Department of Counselor Education program.
