

TCNJ Graduate Credit: Summer 2023

TCNJ's <u>Off-Site Graduate Programs (OSGP)</u> works cooperatively with the Principals' Training Center to provide graduate credit for the completion of specified PTC/TTC/TLI/EAL/CTC workshops. Participants may combine graduate credit from PTC courses with TCNJ programs in the following areas:

- Counselor Education (master's program available)
- Educational Leadership (master's and post-master's certificate programs available)
- Elementary or Secondary Education (master's and certificate programs available)
- Teaching ESL (master's and certificate programs available)

Participants may bank up to **12 credits (4 courses)** with TCNJ, to be applied to a master's degree and/or certificate program. OSGP degree and certificate programs strive to prepare a diverse community of international educators to lead positive change in schools throughout the world and courses are offered on a practical schedule, through both intensive in-person and online experiences.

OSGP is:

- Established: Catering to the unique needs of international educators for more than 40 years.
- Convenient: Travel to the US is <u>NOT</u> required of any program- all coursework is offered overseas or online.
- Accessible: Courses are condensed and offered at practical times/locations.

- 2. Register for graduate credit with PTC and complete required assignment/payment.
- Students who have not banked credit previously with TCNJ must complete a <u>Visiting Student</u> <u>Application</u>. From here, PTC participants will be assigned a TCNJ PAWS ID number and OSGP staff will process banked credit and grade.
- 4. OSGP will confirm registration with PTC participants in August. Information on future OSGP courses and instructions on how to order an official TCNJ transcript will be included in this communication.
- 5. OSGP students may take their first four (4) courses as a Visiting Student. After this time, to continue taking courses, students must <u>apply for admission</u> into their program of study. Detailed information will be provided during the August confirmation email.
