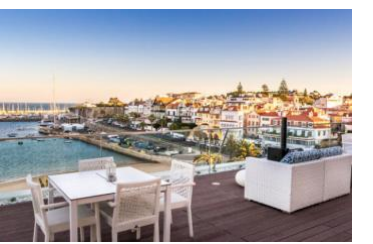


Things to do in Lisbon/Cascais, Portugal

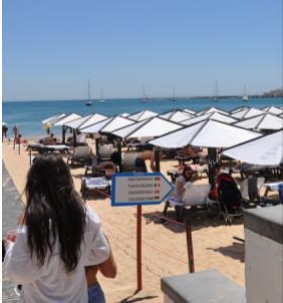
For those of you joining TCNJ in Portugal this summer. Below are a number of attractions that may be of interest to you in your free time.

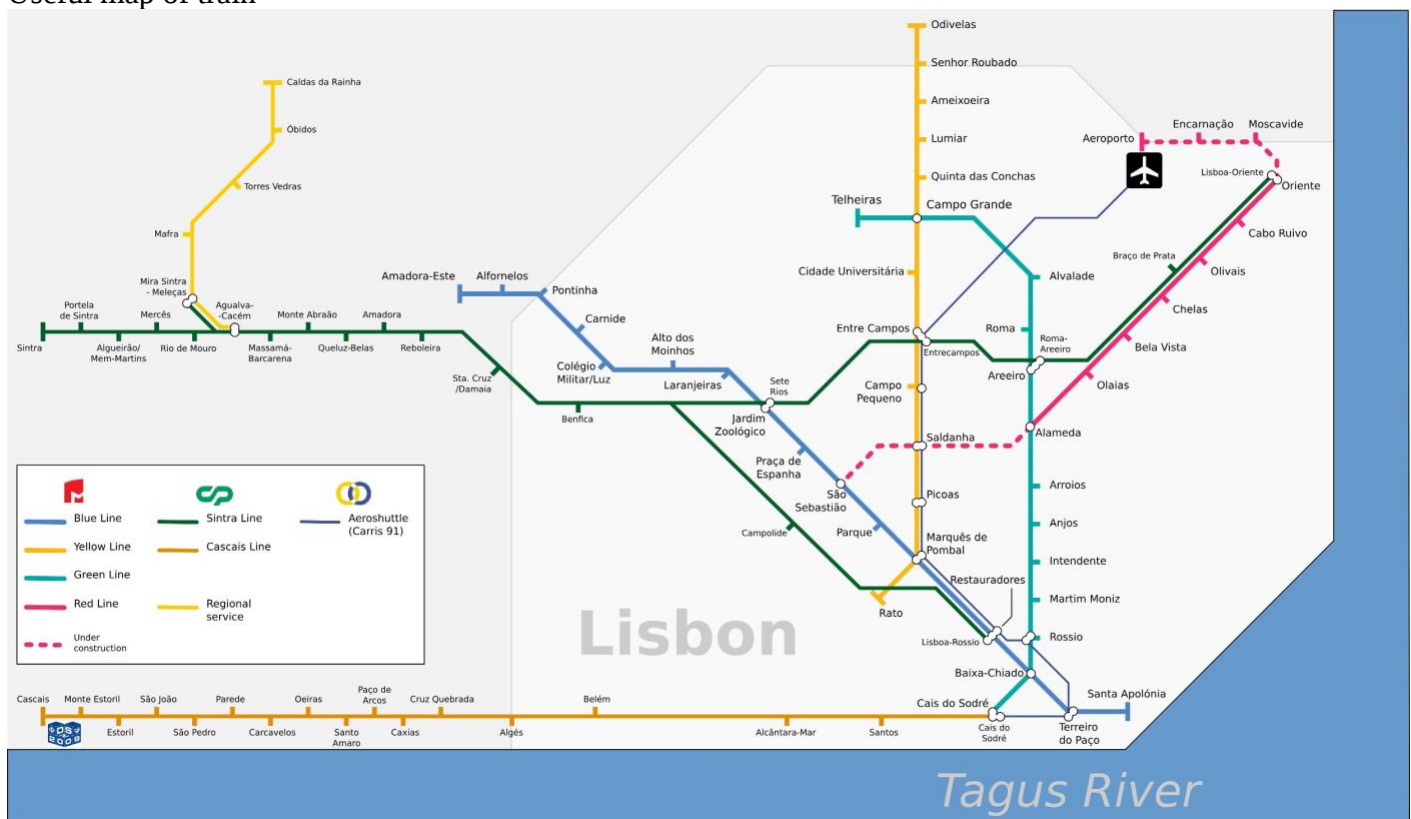

	Elevador de Santa Justa Lisboa, Portugal	“The 'Santa Justa' lift was inaugurated on the 10th July 1902 and it is the only vertical lift in Lisbon for public service. It was built by the architect Raoul Mesnier du Ponsard and has a cast iron structure, enriched with filigree details. 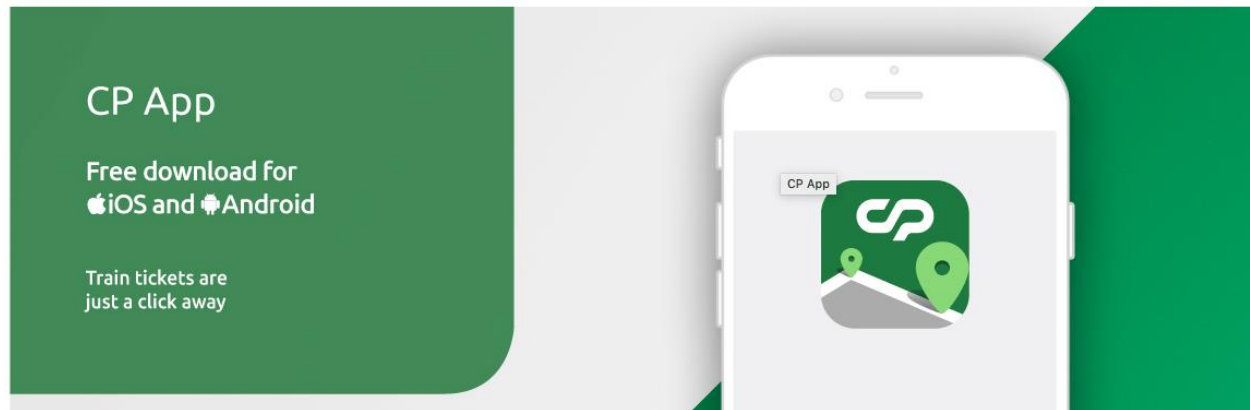
