Visiting Students may take up to 9 graduate credits. If students plan to pursue a Certificate or M.Ed. they must submit all of the admission requirements

Application Requirements:

Complete a Visiting Student Application (no app fee required)

Admission Requirements:

1. Graduate Application
2. \$75 Application Fee (waived if you are a returning TCNJ student, including a visiting student)
3. Official Transcripts (credential evaluation needed if degree is obtained by institution outside US)
4. Standardized Tests (M.Ed only or Testing Waiver Information)
5. Recommendations
6. Student Essay
7. Resumé/CV

Certificate of Qualification (CQ):

The Certificate of Qualification (CQ) is a graduation document and is available to students (US and Non-US Citizens). The CQ was developed by the School of Education and it verifies successful completion of the required graduate coursework for a teacher preparation program. It is a credential widely recognized by International Schools and their accrediting agencies.

Students who have successfully completed the required graduate coursework (Certificate and/or M.Ed.) MUST apply for graduation. Students will receive (6-8 weeks after certificate/degree has been posted) the following graduation documents:

- 1 Diploma (M.Ed. only) - \$100 graduation application fee
2. Certificate of Qualification (CQ) - No app fee
